Direct Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mental Health Worker with Bachelor level training in a field such as counseling, psychology or behavior. Provides direct services to a student in his/her educational placement• Frequency of services is determined by the IEP team and is linked to specific goals on the student's IEP, or by members of the school's child study team for those students who are not identified with special needs• Services can include individual and/or group counseling• ER/RR/IEP Participation
Support to School Personnel	<p>Mental Health Workers are available to provide support to school district teams, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ER/RR/IEP Participation• Social history/updates• Support with classroom management strategies to meet the child's needs• Behavioral observation of students/data collection• Weekly team meetings• Frequency of support to school personnel is determined by the IEP team
Programmatic Consultation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Classroom Strategic Planning• Provide consultative support or staff development to district employees regarding behavioral and mental health related issues• Parent contact/consultation regarding counseling and behavior support
